**S. R. O. No. 1171/2010.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (Act 19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala, hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Jail Subordinate Service Special Rules issued under G. O. (Ms.) No. 1043/59/PD dated the 11th December, 1959 and published in the Kerala Gazette No. 2 dated the 12th of January, 1960, namely:—

### RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Jail Subordinate Service (Amendment) Rules, 2010.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

PRINTED AND PUBLISHED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF GOVERNMENT PRESSES  
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2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In the Kerala Jail Subordinate Service Special Rules,—

- (1) In the opening paragraph beginning with the words "In these rules unless", the words "Open Jail, Women's Prison (Vanitha Jail)", shall be inserted after the words "Central Jail" and before the words "District Jail" and the words "Bala Mandir" shall be omitted.
- (2) The words 'Non-Executive Staff' shall be inserted after the words "Branch II" appearing in Part I.
- (3) In "Part II-Rules," under the heading "Branch I-Executive staff,"—
  - (i) in rule 1, for the existing categories of officers the following categories of officers shall be substituted, namely:—

Category—1 Assistant Jailor Grade-I/Superintendent, Sub Jail/Supervisor, Open Prison/Supervisor, Borstal School/Armourer, State Institute of Correctional Administration/Lecturer, State Institute of Correctional Administration/Training Officer, State Institute of Correctional Administration/Store Keeper, Open Prison.

Category—2 Matron Grade-I

Category—3 Assistant Jailor Grade-II

Category—4 Matron Grade-II

Category—5 Chief Warder/Gate Keeper

(ii) after rule 1, the following notes shall be inserted, namely:—

*Note 1:*—Categories 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 constitute the Warder establishment. It will be a unit-wise establishment maintaining separate seniority list in each unit. State-wise seniority list will be maintained in the case of Female Warders.

*Note 2:*—Unit 1 shall comprise the Jail Institutions in the Revenue Districts of Kasaragode, Kannur, Kozhikode, Wayanad, Malappuram and Palakkad.

*Note 3:*—Unit II shall comprise the Jail Institutions in the Revenue Districts of Thrissur, Ernakulam, Idukki and Kottayam.

*Note 4:*—Unit III shall comprise the Jail Institutions in the Revenue Districts of Alappuzha, Pathanamthitta, Kollam and Thiruvananthapuram.

*Note 5:*—State-wise seniority list will be reckoned on the Warder establishment for the purpose of promotion to other categories.
